Lesson 6:

The Gift

1. Transition to the Good news
A. At this point we have thoroughly explained to the person that they are a sinner and their sin has condemned them to hell
B. Now we can give them the which is the gospel
BTW: The word "gospel" means "good tidings" or "good news!"

3. How this conversation may go:
A. God has a gift he wants to give you
#1. Read the passage:
Script (Set up for the verse): Remember this verse we saw earlier. Romans 6:23. We saw "For the wages of sin is death" – we understand what the means now, right? Our payment for the result of our sin is death. Not just a physical death, but the second death of He or the Lake of Fire. But notice the second part of the verse. (Read the verse)
Romans 6:23: For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
<u>FYI:</u> Earlier in our conversation, we focused on the first part of this verse (the bad news) – now v

will focus on the second part of this verse (the good news).

#2. Reveal the truth:

Explanation:

God has a "gift" he wants to give us, and that "gift" is "eternal life", and it is through "Jesus Christ." Let me show you a few things about this gift.

#3. Review the concept:

Transition:

I would like you to remember these words: "gift," "eternal life," and "Jesus Christ."

B. You don't have to work for the gift

#1. Read the passage:

Ephesians 2:8-9:

For by <u>grace</u> are ye <u>saved</u> through <u>faith</u>; and that <u>not of yourselves</u>: it is the <u>gift of God</u>: <u>Not of works</u>, lest any man should boast.

#2. Reveal the truth:

Illustration: The Birthday Gift!

Soul Winner:

Let's say today was your birthday, and let's say I was going to give you a gift – let's use this pen for example (hold out a pen, or your Bible or anything you have). What would you have to do for this gift to become yours? (Hold it out to them.)

Sinner:

I don't know, just take it.

Soul Winner:

Yes, go ahead and take it! (Hand it to them) Is that your gift now? I just gave it to you right? Now, what if I said, "Well, you know, that pen cost me one dollar. I'm going to give you a <u>free</u> birthday gift, but you must give me one dollar, is that a gift?"

Sinner:

No.

Soul Winner:

Why not?

Sinner:

Because I am paying for it.

Soul Winner:

You've right, a gift (by definition) is free. What if I said, "Okay, you don't have to give me any money, all you have to do is wash my car, is that a gift?"

Sinner:

No.

Soul Winner:

Why not?

Sinner:

Because I'm doing something for it.

Soul Winner:

Exactly, because if you wash my car, what are you doing for it? You're now working for it! See, a gift is free! You cannot pay for it, and you cannot work for it – otherwise it is not a gift!

The gift of God is the exact same way. Notice what the Bible says about God's gift – it says it is "[n]ot of works, lest any man should boast."

Thoughts on the "Birthday Gift" Illustrations:

- 1) Start off with, "what if I asked you to pay me for the gift"—because it is very easy to grasp that you don't pay for a gift
- 2) Then I transition into, "What if I asked you to do something for it"—this is how we apply the illustration to salvation
- 3) An illustration is worthless if you don't apply it
- **4)** An additional verse you could use for someone who is really struggling with this concept is Romans 4:5

#3. Review the concept:

Question:

So, according to the Bible, do you have to work or earn the gift of eternal life that God wants to give you?

Action Step: Mark and highlight Romans 6:23 and Ephesians 2:8-9 in your Bible.
